Criteria for Visual and Performing Arts Identification

Visual Art:

Students will be assessed on a rubric earning from 0-3 points in the following areas: <u>Creating</u> – Inventiveness and Improvisation, Composition, Rapidity of Development, Complexity and Elaboration, Technical Skills, Sensitivity to art media; and <u>Responding</u> – Critical judgment and self reflection and critical analysis of personal works of art.

A score of 16-20 is needed for screening to move on to the ID process. A score of 21-24 is needed for identification.





Musical performance (instrumental and vocal):

Students will be assessed on a rubric earning from 0-3 points in the following areas: Rhythm, melody, improvisation, expressiveness, engagement, technique, and over-all performance.

A score of 14-17 is needed for screening to move onto the ID process.


A score of 18-21 is needed for identification.

Dance:

Students will be assessed on a rubric earning from 0-3 points in the following areas: Memory and recall in prepared performance,

memory and recall in other performance evaluation activities; temporal awareness in prepared performance, temporal awareness in other performance evaluation activities; body awareness in prepared performance, bod awareness in other performance evaluation activities; movement quality awareness in prepared performance, movement quality awareness in other performance evaluation activities; and expressiveness in prepared performance, and expressiveness in other performance evaluation activities.

A score of 20-25 is needed for screening to move onto the ID process.





Drama

Students will be assessed on a rubric earning from 0-3 points in the following areas: Physical performance, imagination, improvisation, characterization, engagement, technique, communication of meaning, and over-all performance. A score of 16-19 is needed for screening to pass a student on for ID.

A score of 20-24 is needed for identification.
